Thank you for choosing Bonneville Child Nutrition for your student meals! We are proud to offer breakfast and lunch each day to all students. Free and reduced priced meals are available to those who qualify (Apply at frapps.horizonsolana.com/BONJ01.) Menus are available online at d93schools.org and are subject to change due to availability of product.

LUNCH MONEY

Bonneville Child Nutrition uses a debit account cafeteria system. MyPaymentsPlus is available as a prepaid option for student meal accounts. The website can be accessed through our District website or at <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com>.

Every student is expected to prepay for his/her meal account or have cash/check at the time of purchase. We recommend parents prepay BEFORE students run out of money. Parents can deposit money onto the student's account through MyPaymentsPlus. When a student's account balance reaches negative (\$.01), a phone call and email will be made notifying parents of the negative balance.

Any remaining meal balance at year's end will be carried over to the next school year.

Students leaving the District should request a refund. At the end of the school year, all inactive student account balances will be transferred to sibling accounts, if available. All remaining balances (for inactive students only) will be considered a donation and will be transferred to the Child Nutrition Donation account and used to cover year end negative balances.

NEGATIVE BALANCES

Students at the elementary and middle school level are allowed two charges and high school students are not allowed to charge (Board Policy #8415). After two charges, students will be given an alternate meal. When a student's account balance reaches negative (\$.01), a phone call and/or email will be made notifying parents of the negative balance. Parents can pay for a student's account balance in the cafeteria or online at <https://www.mypaymentsplus.com>. Parents are encouraged to set up customized alerts in MyPaymentsPlus.

FREE or REDUCED PRICE MEALS

All parents are encouraged to fill out a free and reduced application either in paper form or online at frapps.horizonsolana.com/BONJ01. **A NEW FORM IS REQUIRED EVERY SCHOOL YEAR.** Free or reduced prices apply to 1 breakfast and 1 lunch per day per student. Students must take the meal minimum as set by the USDA. A la carte items are not eligible for free or reduced prices. Second meals will be charged at adult prices.

SPECIAL DIETARY REQUESTS
