



## Phoenix Advisory Groups

### Parent Information Sheet

#### Goals:

1. Build relationships with students
2. Retention of students – raise graduation rate
3. Teach career skills that will help students with life after high school
4. Help advise students at Lincoln High School

#### Schedule:

1. The advisory groups will meet the last 30 minutes of each Thursday alternating between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> period. (5 minute passing, 25 minute advise time)
2. Makeup time for not showing or tardies will apply to the classes they are in
3. Morning announcements will be given on the day of group as a reminder
4. Schedules will be posted in each teachers' classroom

#### Groups:

1. Students will be divided by grade level – 9/10, 11, 12, 12+
2. Teachers will be assigned a group
3. Teachers and students will be in the same group until the students graduate.
4. Changes can be made – must be approved by Mrs. Likes and Mr. Miller
5. Once a group graduates, the teacher will be assigned to incoming students to start building the relationships again.

#### Activities:

1. Each track will have an assigned topic.
2. Lesson Plans and activity guides will be shared with all of the teachers so the students are receiving the same instruction throughout each track.
3. There will be 3 lessons and 2 directed discussions
4. A list of directed discussion topics will be shared
5. The schedule for the lessons and discussions will be up to the teachers and students within each group.

#### Policies:

1. Students are required to attend.
2. Make-up time applies.
3. Referrals for disrupting the group.
